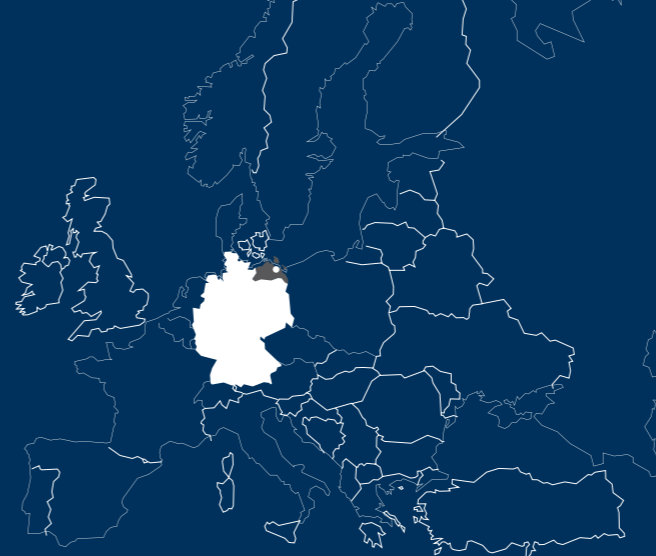

It is a great pleasure to invite you to take part in the 3rd International Conference for Plasma Medicine which is to be held in Greifswald, Germany from 19th-24th September, 2010.

Venue: The conference will take place in the newly built town hall in Greifswald's old theatre district. The venue is close to the city centre and near the accommodation for delegates. There are some nice hotels with different star ratings in the area and also several guest houses. Details will be published closer to the conference dates.

Travel: Berlin and Hamburg International Airports can be reached within 2.5 h by train and car. A detailed timetable for the train connections can be obtained at the travel service of the Deutsche Bahn from: www.reiseauskunft.bahn.de. To reach Greifswald by car it is easiest to take the motorway A20. An alternative air connection is to arrive in Germany via Munich and take a connecting flight to Rostock/Laage which is situated near the motorways A19 and A20.

Conference Style: The format for the conference series is well established. Abstracts are refereed, as are the four-page papers which are all orally presented at conference sessions. In line with recent conferences for plasma medicine, there will be modest page charges and a moderate conference fee to cover the cost of the proceedings etc. There are to be plenary sessions with invited speakers, and workshop arrangements for current topics of major scientific interest.

Accompanying Persons: Delegates are most welcome to bring their families and guests. Visits will be organized for them to various locations. Greifswald has many attractions such as the museal harbour with its maritime touch, the Cathedral St. Nikolai, the monastery ruins of Eldena, the theatre and the Regional Museum of Pomerania.

Invitation Letters: The secretariat will provide a letter of invitation to the conference by request from any of the delegates. These letters will not imply funding support or paper acceptance by the organizers.

On behalf of the Local Organizing Committee, we hope that we will be welcoming you to Greifswald in September, 2010.
