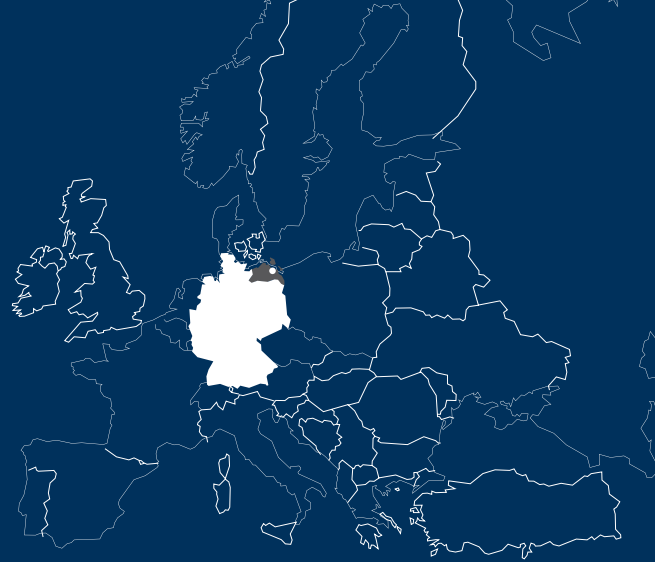

## ICPM 3 & plasmatis

It is a great pleasure to invite you to take part in the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference for Plasma Medicine which is to be held in Greifswald, Germany from 19<sup>th</sup> -24<sup>th</sup> September, 2010.

**Call for Abstracts:** Intending authors are invited to submit abstracts for posters or talks for acceptance by our scientific panels. This should be done on the website. The deadline for the receipt of abstracts is February 28, 2010. Until that date abstracts can be edited on the website. For submission please open an account as author and upload your abstracts in 4 steps. Follow the explanations for the submission process on the website. Fill in title and abstract. Abstracts must be written in English and should not be longer than 250 words. The acceptance process will start in March and ends in April, 2010. Afterwards you will get the notification if your abstract is accepted for oral or poster presentation. There will be a "best poster award".

## Scientific Topics

- plasma sources for medicine
- plasma based sterilization/decontamination
- plasma cell and plasma tissue interaction
- plasma surface modification for biomedical application
- medical aspects and results of plasma in use

**Venue:** The conference will take place in Greifswald in the biochemistry lecture hall. The venue is close to the city centre and near the accommodation for delegates.

**Accommodation:** There are various hotels with different star ratings in the area and also several guest houses. For accommodation reservation please use the form on [www.icpm3.org](http://www.icpm3.org). There is a special accommodation for students available.

**Travel:** The International Airports of Berlin and Hamburg can be reached within 2.5 h by train or car. A detailed timetable for the train connections can be obtained at the travel service of the Deutsche Bahn: [www.reiseauskunft.bahn.de](http://www.reiseauskunft.bahn.de). To reach Greifswald by car, it is easiest to take the motorway A20. An alternative air connection is to arrive in Germany via Munich and take a connecting flight to Rostock/Laage which is situated near the motorways A19 and A20. (1h drive by car in addition)

**Fees:** The registration fees cover the cost of the proceedings, the conference dinner, the morning and afternoon refreshments and the welcome reception on Sunday evening. The cost for accompanying persons will not be included in the registration fee. Fees are non-refundable.

400 Euro for regular delegates  
250 Euro for research-students
